At **Silverwoods Forest School**, caring for our woodland environment is at the heart of everything we do. We believe that children learn best when they are connected to nature, and part of that connection is understanding how to look after it. Our aim is for every session to leave as little trace as possible on the woodland around us.

We follow an ongoing **woodland sustainability and management plan** to ensure the trees, plants, and wildlife at our site are cared for throughout the year. Each activity is designed with respect for the natural environment and to inspire children to become future guardians of the planet.

Our Forest School site at **The Weald C of E Primary School** includes access to **children's toilets and hand-washing facilities with hot water**, located just a short walk from the woodland.

All rubbish collected during sessions is carefully **sorted, recycled, or reused** wherever possible.

We use **eco-friendly hand soap and cleaning products**, ensuring that no harmful chemicals enter the soil or waterways. All our **firewood is sustainably sourced**, and we continually review our materials and suppliers to reduce waste and environmental impact.

Through every decision we make, from our teaching resources to how we manage our woodland, Silverwoods Forest School remains committed to protecting the planet for future generations of explorers.
